




Dear TLC Families,

I hope this message finds you well and enjoying a nice summer. We have been very busy at TLC these days and weeks, and we are all excited to welcome students back on campus for the upcoming 2021-22 school year! We have several important and exciting announcements to share with you regarding TLC and plans for this year. Please see below:

- TLC is growing! To accommodate all new and returning students in the 2021-22 school year, TLC will be adding new classrooms at a nearby site for our growing school. We are looking forward to showing everyone the new space and all it has to offer with larger classrooms, spaces to run and play, and a safe and secure environment for all. Below are pictures and a map of the location so everyone can find us! Please note the grade levels that will be offered at each site:
 - o 1130 E Walnut Ave (current site): TK, Kindergarten
 - o 250 S Yorba Street (new location): Grades 1 6















Additional note: We are currently working out final details for transportation across the sites as needed for families. We will send a survey in the coming weeks to all families to determine needs for drop-off/pick-up at each location. Please watch for more information to come!

- ▶ FREE After School Program for ALL: TLC is pleased to announce that ALL students will have the opportunity to participate in our After School program this coming year, scheduled from 3:00 p.m. 5:30 p.m. daily. After School programming will include supplemental instruction in Literacy and Math as needed for students, homework help, social-emotional supports and interest-based enrichments such as art, drama, athletics, gaming/coding, and more! This program will be provided tuition-free for all students, and is specifically intended to address learning recovery and to help rebuild our caring learning community at TLC. We hope your child(ren) will join us!
- <u>Health and Safety Update</u>: Last week, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) released updated guidance for K-12 schools (https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CID/DCDC/Pages/COVID-19/K-12-Guidance-2021-2 2-School-Year.aspx) for the 2021-22 school year. This guidance specifies that:
 - o K-12 students and school staff will be required to wear masks indoors. (Note that public schools must follow this guidance to operate for in-person instruction. CPDH will revisit and reconsider mask guidelines no later than November 1, 2021).
 - o Physical distancing and ventilation remain important factors for safety.
 - o Enhanced cleaning and hygiene practices are important for safety.
 - o Students and staff should make sure to stay home if sick or showing symptoms of sickness (e.g. fever, cough) at any time.

Additional note: TLC will present all health and safety measures for our school in detail at upcoming Family Welcome meetings in early August. Please keep watch for notices and join us to learn more!
